You may represent yourself or have an attorney there to represent you. Please be advised that inability to pay is <u>not</u> a defense to liability for erroneous homestead exemption(s), and that the administrative law judge is unable to negotiate terms of payment. All payments for erroneous homestead exemption(s) must be made in full.

Where do I send this request for an administrative hearing?

You must mail or deliver this form to the Assessor's Office within thirty (30) days of receiving the Notice of Intent to Record Lien letter. If you do not act within this period, you will lose your right to a hearing. Please mail or deliver this form to the following address:
